cine, Arshed Quyyumi, said,

"People attending the health fair were consented to participate in a study being conducted at Emory University Hospital, Department of Medicine, Division of Cardiology. The study is designed to discover novel genetic and blood biomarkers of increased risk of cardiovascular (heart and blood vessel) diseases including high blood pressure and diabetes in South Asians. Blood samples were collected and stored for subsequent analysis of DNA for discovery of genetic risk factors. In addition, subjects underwent testing of arterial stiffness that measures early abnormalities of blood vessels. Abnormal arterial stiffness may be present even before any conditions such as hypertension or heart disease become evident. These results were explained to the participating subjects. Fifteen physicians, researchers, students and volunteers from Emory helped conduct this study and a total of 100 men and women participated in this study."

In his appreciatory comments, Antony Thaliath, the Executive Director of Gandhi Foundation of USA said, "It was indeed a very pleasant sight to see people coming in big numbers from early morning to the Sai Health Fair at the Sardar Bhavan organized by The Gujarati Samaj and co-sponsored by The Gandhi Foundation of USA.
